The community swimming pool will be open for the 2019 swim season beginning Saturday, May 4, at 6:00 a.m. The pool will be open as "Swim At Your Own Risk" until the lifeguard service begins on Saturday, May 25, at 12:00 noon. See the schedule below for days and hours of operation. The pool will be closed on Mondays, and Thursday mornings only, for super cleaning & chlorination. The only exceptions to Monday closures are Memorial Day and Labor Day. In those 2 cases the pool will be closed the following day. The lifeguard service will end after Labor Day week-end, however, the pool will remain open as "Swim At Your Own Risk" through Sunday, September 29.

\* If you miss the registration dates, you may contact resident, Christie Keggins, to schedule an appointment with her to register. Christie can be reached at 410-615-2575. \*

- If you have previously registered and have an access card, no action is necessary on your part.
- Pool cards do not expire from year to year.
- **If you purchased your home resale after Labor Day 2018 and have a card(s) left from the previous owner, those cards are being deleted from the system and you must register your household and get a new card.**
- If you are leasing your home, your Landlord must send permission in writing (or email) to the Association office in order for you to register and obtain an access card.
- Your initial pool card is at no charge. There is a \$10 charge for a 2<sup>nd</sup> card; 2 card maximum per household.
- There is a limit of (5) guests permitted per household.
- The pool is not available to rent for private parties.
- Failure to comply with pool rules entitles the Association to suspend an owner's right to utilize the pool for the remainder of the season. Suspension to be enforced through deactivation of pool access cards issued to the property address.
